# Pumpkin Covered Candy Dish

Decorating Technique

#### SUGGESTED MATERIALS:

<u>Ware</u>: Pumpkin Box & Lid, DM1106, cleaned and fired to 04.

<u>Duncan Glaze</u>: Very Black, IN1026.

<u>Duncan Bisq-Stains</u>: Orange Peel, OS438; Bright Green, OS464;

Black, 05476.

<u>Duncan Ultra Metallics</u>: Antique Gold, UM952; Copper, UM954;

Green, UM959.

Duncan Brushes: #1 Liner, SB802 or TB727; #6 Fan Glaze,

SB807;  $\frac{3}{4}$ " Square Shader, TB733 or Glaze, TB715.

<u>Miscellaneous Supplies</u>: Replacement sponge, water bowl, palette, palette knife, paper towels, tissue paper, thin green floral wire,

hot glue gun or white glue.

# Preparation:

Sponge bisque to remove any dust. Glaze inside of box with Black gloss glaze and fire to cone 06.

## Painting Instructions:

Load the Fan Glaze brush with Black and paint the entire outside of the pumpkin making sure that none of the bisque shows through. Using the square shader, dry brush (or wet brush) Orange Peel over the pumpkin and Bright Green over the leaves and stem. When the color is sufficiently developed, dry brush Green UM over the leaves and stem. In the same manner, apply Copper and Antique Gold over the pumpkin, as well as a little on the leaves and stem.

### Finishing:

Cut about 5 pieces of floral wire 3-4 inches long and twist them around a pencil or the handle of a brush to make it curl. Glue these around the stem and add some color to make them blend with the pumpkin leaves.

Sign your piece with a liner brush under one of the leaves.
