Palette for Paint

1. Using Pattern and clay carbon trace large pattern in center of Baker and the small pattern on the sides between handles.
2. With a damp sponge, wipe piece to remove dust and prepare for decorating.
3. On palette place Neon Yellow, Neon Orange and Neon Red.
4. Using a round brush apply one coat of Neon Yellow to all peppers.
5. Using round brush load in Neon Yellow and side load in Neon Orange, keep Neon Yellow to outside of pepper apply one coat, pulling stroke from top of pepper to bottom. Repeat for all peppers. Refer to Diagram \#1
6. Using round brush load in Neon Orange and side load in Neon Red, keep Neon Red to opposite edge from Neon Yellow pull from top to bottom of pepper.
7. For brighter peppers apply a second coat following steps 5 thru 6.
8. Add to palette Bright Kelp and Dark Kelp. Apply one coat of Bright Kelp to all leaves and pepper tops.
9. Using round brush load in Bright Kelp and tip in Dark Kelp. Keep the Dark Kelp to the bottom of leaves and pepper tops. This will create a shadow on the leaves.
10. Add to palette Dark Black, thin color to the consistency of ink. Using a liner brush outline and detail piece. Refer to detail diagram \#2
11. Using shader brush and Neon Orange paint striped around to edge of baker and on handles. Apply a second coat.
12. Using the wooden end of brush or dot maker place Neon Red dots between strips.
13. All piece to dry over night.
14. Apply 2 coats of clear glaze, using fan glaze brush.
15. When dry stilt and fire to shelf con 06.
16. Don't forget to remove stilt marks.
